

The Lottery Corporation (**we**, **us** and **our**) uses cookies and similar technologies on our websites and mobile applications to collect or access information stored on your device or computer. This information ranges from unique user identifiers to user play preferences. You can find out more about cookies and similar technologies, and how we use them, in the information set out below. Any information that we collect will be handled in accordance with our <u>Privacy Policy</u>.

If you do not accept the use of these cookies or similar technologies, you can disable them by accessing the support set out in this policy below or by changing your browser settings so that cookies or similar technologies from our websites or applications cannot be placed on your computer or mobile device.

What is a cookie?

A 'cookie' is a small text file that uniquely identifies your browser or device. The cookie file is stored on your browser. When you return to that website (or visit websites that use the same cookies) these websites recognise the cookies and your browsing device.

Cookies allow you to navigate between web pages efficiently, remembering your preferences and activities. They assist in improving and personalising the user experience. For example, cookies can tell us whether you have visited our websites before. They can also help serve you advertisements that are relevant to you.

There are different types of cookies:

- First-party cookies cookies which are served directly from our websites

 (www.thelotterycorporation.com, www.thelott.com, www.keno.com.au) to your computer or device.
 These cookies enable us to conduct analytics (for example, what time our website is the busiest) and personalise your experience (for example, saving your 'favourites').
- **Third-party cookies** cookies that are served by a third party on our behalf. These third parties include social media and online platforms such as Meta, Google, LinkedIn and digital marketing services. We have arrangements with these third parties allowing them to serve cookies on our behalf. These cookies are primarily used to personalise advertisements that are served to you to make sure they are relevant.

Necessary Cookies

Some cookies used by us are strictly necessary for our websites to function. They are usually only set in response to actions made by you which amount to a request for services, such as setting your location preferences, logging in or completing forms. You can set your browser to block or alert you about these cookies, but some parts of our website function for you.

Akamai CDN	We use Akamai cookies to deliver digital content to our customers. Akamai CDN (Content Delivery network) uses cached, or replicated content required by our digital platforms. Google Universal Analytics and DoubleClick Floodlight	We use Google cookies for a number of purposes including; understanding how our media campaigns work and how you interact with our website in order to improve user experience; to store randomly generated User-ID's which allows Google to recognise you across multiple websites and to serve personalised ads; and to understand if you complete certain actions on our websites after you have seen or clicked through one of our adverts served via Google.
